## Clinical Research Associate

This position will be expected to oversee, organize, and implement all aspects of the PI's research studies, with a primary focus on the PI's interdisciplinary research studies on primary progressive aphasia (PPA). The successful candidate will play a principal role in the recruitment of participants into the PPA program and will maintain subject relationships for longitudinal follow up.

Responsibilities may include the supervision and mentoring of other research assistants and trainees, establishing interactions with extramural collaborators, and ensuring regulatory compliance. This position will provide grant application support to the PI, prepare and present reports related to research data, implement database management for the PPA project, and assist with manuscript preparation.

The candidate should have the capability to independently conduct parts of research projects in collaboration with the principal investigator. Research background, familiarity with computers, basic knowledge of statistics and excellent organizational and interpersonal skills are required. Familiarity with database management is desirable. Research modalities will include cognitive testing, imaging, data management, and data analysis. MA, MS, or RN degrees are preferred. Additional clinical interactions (e.g., nursing support, patient counseling, community outreach) related to the research project may also be involved depending on the qualifications of the applicant.
